#### NSS REPORT FOR 2018-19

The NSS unit of Don Bosco College of Engineering, started in the year 2012-13, is currently in its 7<sup>th</sup> year.

### 14. NSS Special Camp:

The NSS unit of Don Bosco College of Engineering had its annual Special Camp from 25th February to 3rd March 2018 at Nirmal Nature Campsite, Tilamol,

Quepem. Fourty Two (42) NSS volunteers (Boys - 25, Girls – 17) attended the camp. The volunteers were accompanied by staff members Prof. Chetan Gaonkar (NSS Programme Officer), Prof. Harison Cota (Ex - NSS Programme Officer) Dr. Avertano Barreto (Sports Officer) and lady staff Prof. Steefni Cruz, and Prof. Akshata Kudchadker.

The work undertaken during this camp was, Poster making competition on Open Defecation Free Village/India and Plastic Free Village/India; Conducted survey in Tilamol village for knowing their difficulties, especially related to open defecation and plastic waste management; Conducted a talk on oyster mushroom cultivation and vegetable cultivation for villagers with the help of zonal agriculture department, quepem in association with Unnat Bharat Abhiyan, DBCE; Collected plastic waste from the village and handed it over to concerned authorities of Tilamol Muncipality; Cleaned the backyard and surroundings of local school in the village by cutting wild grass and collecting dried leaves; Carried out the rally in the village with the theme of Open defecation Free Village/India and Plastic Free Village/India.

The volunteers also presented a cultural programme for the villagers consisting of Group Song, mime, moral based skit, dance performances, NSS song, and comedy skits by the staff. Dr. Avertano Barreto (Sports Officer) was the chief guest for the event. The cultural programme was followed by dinner and camp-fire.

# Blood Donation Camp held on 24th April 2019 at Don Bosco College of Engineering

The NSS unit of Don Bosco College of Engineering, Fatorda in association with Rotract Club of Margao and Blood Bank, Hospicio Hospital, Margao conducted a blood donation camp in the institute premises on 24<sup>th</sup> April 2019. A seven member team of blood bank headed by Dr Ravin Rego, visited the institute for the blood collection. Also present were Rev. Fr. Kinley D'Cruz, Director, Dr. Neena Panandikar, Principal, Prof. Ajit Salunke, HOD Mechanical Eng., Rtr. Ravish Verlekar, President, Rotract Club, Rtr. Scania Rebelo, Secretary, Rotract Club . Altogether 74 students, staff and members of Rotract Club of Margao came forward to donate blood. However due to haemoglobin, pressure and other medical conditions, 13 could not donate. In all 61 students, staff and members of Rotract Club donated blood and helped save many lives. This is the second blood donation camp conducted by the NSS unit in this academic year and was coordinated by Prof. Chetan Gaonkar, NSS Program Officer and Rtr. Scania Rebelo, Secretary, Rotract Club, Margao.

# Report of Road Safety Awareness Program held on 24<sup>th</sup> January 2019 at Don Bosco College of Engineering

## REPORT ON SWACHHTA HI SEVA

### 1. AWARENESS CAMPAIGN

As a part of 'Swachhta Hi Seva', an Awareness Campaign was conducted by NSS DBCE Unit by organizing a visit to Hindustan Waste Treatment Pvt. Ltd., on 19<sup>th</sup> September 2018.
